

Surrey Summer Meet - Entry Details



Swimmers must arrive “beach ready” with Kit bag and a plastic bag to use for wet clothing. Face Coverings are required at all times & Sanitation stations will be provided throughout.

- ✓ Using the Surrey Event Entrance, all Swimmers, Coaches, Officials, and non-technical Volunteers pass through the covid checkpoint.
- Coaches and non-technical Volunteers will proceed to collect their accreditation passes (close to the entrance)
- All Swimmers, Coaches, Officials, and non-technical officials head upstairs.
- Swimmers and non-technical volunteers will head towards **Sports Arena A on the first floor** (Blue lines for Swimmers and non-Tech. & Green lines for Coaches.)
- Officials will follow the yellow line and head to the **World Cup Suite on the first floor**

Swimmers – Flow-through for warm up



Swimmers will be marshalled & escorted from Sports Arena A – All Swimmers must wear a Face covering throughout the time in the SSP. Only during warm up and racing can face coverings be removed.

- Swimmers will be marshalled by event. Each event will be allocated 2 marshals who will remain with the swimmers throughout their warmup and their race event.
 - Using the Key Times report, Swimmers will check into the marshalling queue in Sports Hall A
 - Swimmers must take their kitbags and plastic change bag to the marshalling queue.
 - 2 marshals will escort swimmers via the rear exit of the sports hall and proceed to the pool, following the blue line.
 - Swimmers will place their bags on the far end of the pool marked with “Warm up” Kit bags.
 - Marshalls will oversee the warm-up ensuring no more than 10 swimmers in a lane.
 - Each warmup will be restricted to 20 minutes, when a sharp exit is needed. Sprint Lanes will not be used for this event.
 - After warmup, swimmers will get out of the pool, collect their bags, and move directly to the changing areas – follow red line to the changing rooms.
 - No showers will be in use.
 - There are 30 individual changing rooms, and two group changing rooms. Swimmers may need to wait outside the individual changing rooms if all are busy.
 - Once changed swimmers will exit the changing rooms and follow the red line back to the Sports Arena, ready for their race.
- **Note, All Event Personnel, must use the one-way system above.**

Swimmers – Flow-through for Racing



Swimmers will be marshalled & escorted from Sports Arena A – All Swimmers must wear a Face covering throughout the time in the SSP. Only during warm up and racing can face coverings be removed.

- Swimmers will be marshalled by event. Each event will be allocated 2 marshals who will remain with the swimmers throughout their warmup and their race event.
- Using the Key Times report, Swimmers will check into the marshalling queue in Sports Hall A
- Swimmers must take their kitbags and plastic change bag to the marshalling queue.
- 2 marshals will escort swimmers via the rear exit of the sports hall and proceed to the pool, following the blue line.
- Swimmers will take their kits bags and plastic bags to the Starting blocks.
- Marshalls will marshal swimmers to the racing blocks from the shower entrance
- Swimmers will queue from the shower entrance down the far side of the pool (swimmers will sit where possible, facing forward whilst wearing masks)
- Swimmers will exit the pool at the far side and collect their bags from the blocks. Then move towards the starter following the blue line around the pool until they reach the changing rooms.
- No showers will be in use.
- There are 30 individual changing rooms, and two group changing rooms. Swimmers may need to wait outside the individual changing rooms if all are busy.
- Once changed swimmers will exit the changing rooms and follow the red line back to the Sports Arena, or event exit to meet parents etc.
