2016 Surrey County ASA Platform Championships

You are cordially invited to enter divers into this year's Surrey County ASA Platform Championships to be held at Guildford Spectrum, Parkway, Guildford, Surrey GU1 1UP on Saturday 24 September.

Platform will follow the Surrey Schools and 3m Championships.

Medals will be awarded to the top three Surrey divers in each event and Guest medals to any non-Surrey divers finishing in the top three. All dives will be from the 5m platform.

Please return your entries on the form below, either by post or e-mail, to reach me no later than Friday 9 September.

Arrangements on dive sheets, draft start lists and a timetable will be circulated once all the entries have been collated.

A competition e-programme will be available to view, print or download in the Diving section of the Surrey County ASA website during the week leading up to the meet.

Cheques to cover the diver entry fees must be made payable to Surrey County ASA – at £10 per event.

Surrey County ASA Platform Championships

The FINA technical rules of diving shall be used in all diving championships wherever possible.

Ages:

Ages recorded at 31st December in the year of the competition.

Junior is defined as 8 to 18 years of age (inclusive) in the year of competition.

Conditions:

Junior (Girls): 5 voluntary dives from at least 4 different groups (5m, 7½m)

Junior (Boys): 5 voluntary dives from at least 4 different groups (5m, 7½m)

Senior (Women): 6 voluntary dives from at least 4 different groups (5m, 7½m, 10m)

Senior (Men): 7 voluntary dives from at least 5 different groups (5m, 7½m, 10m)

Forward and or back jumps are not allowed in championships.

A dive of the same number may not be repeated.

Any dispute or questions arising that the foregoing conditions do not provide shall be determined as the Competition Committee sees fit.

Due to time constraints, it will be necessary to continue to combine the junior and senior highboard championships. Eligible divers competing in both shall use only one dive sheet on which the dives must fulfil the senior championship conditions, with its first 5 dives satisfying the junior championship conditions.

The points from the first 5 dives will be extracted directly for the junior results.
