

VACANCY – Surrey County Coach

2022 - 2023

Applications are invited for the role of **Surrey County Coach** whose responsibility will include:

- County Pathway Camps (11 year olds)
- National County Team Championships (12 – 17 year olds)

This role will be given high visibility in the County. The successful candidate will be actively involved in the team selection process of the Age Group swimmers, and given the opportunity to work directly with highly talented, top County swimmers ensuring a good level of success at camps and competition.

The role of **County Coach** is an appointment that runs for two years.

Applicants should meet all of the following criteria:

- Existing Coach from a Surrey Club
- UKCC Level 2 qualified coach or above
- Actively involved with the coaching of Age Group swimmers in their current club
- Be actively involved in County or Regional programmes
- Experienced - Have a proven track record of success with Age Group swimming
- Carry a current DBS certification

Time commitment:

- Attendance and participation for the selection of Age Group swimmers (County Camps and County Championships, limited travelling involved)
- Attendance at the 3 x Day camps at a Surrey Venue (April, June & October)
- Attendance at the annual Coach workshop held by Swim England (February)
- To provide coaching plans & talks / presentation preparation for each of the 11 year old camps. (No travel time involved)
- Attendance and organisation of the County Team building session in readiness for the National County Championships (September)
- To attend the weekend of the National County Team Championships (October)

Personal attributes:

- Good communication skills
- Energetic with a high level of motivation skills
- Ability to travel with the team and be away

Expenses:

All reasonable expenses will be reimbursed. Hotel accommodation and subsistence at the National County Team Championships will be provided. The County camps will be remunerated in line with the Swim England pathway programme guidance.
