There will be three sessions during the day, racing in one half of the pool, with the second half available for continuous warm-up/down. The results from the Championships will also be used to assist in team selection for the Master's Inter-County Championship held on 15th November 2026, further details, including venue, to be advised when available. Awards

- Club Championship Trophies – Top Club, Top Men's Club, Top Ladies' Club, and TopRelay Club.
- Top eight places score points towards Club Trophies and Victor Ludorum awards to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in individual and relay events.
- Victor Ludorum Trophies for each 10-year age group (25-34, 35-44, etc.) and Seniors. Depending on time, trophy awards may not be presented at the championships.

Relay teams

Team events are in age groups, Senior (72-119), 120-159, 160-199, 200-239 240-279 & 280+. A "Senior" relay consists of at least one swimmer who is in the Senior Age Group 18-24 (e.g. one Senior plus three Masters, of any age, is always a Senior relay).


Mixed teams consist of 2 male and 2 female, swum in any order. Senior swimmers may only swim in Senior Relays, but Master's may swim down in a Senior Relay.

All team entries should be made in advance using the on-line entry portal. Team members can be added up to 8 swimmers and the swim order amended at any time before midnight on Friday 26 June. Changes can also be made on the day up to one hour before the start of the session concerned in person with the Meet Manager at the Timing desk.

Clubs may enter any number of teams per age-group, per event. As with individual swims, all relay age-groups will swim together in each event (Medley and Freestyle), and awards will be made for each age-group. A swimmer therefore may only swim for one age group in each relay event. (For example, a swimmer in the 120-159 Freestyle relay team may not swim in the 160-199 Freestyle relay team. The same swimmer may swim in the 160-199 Medley relay providing they are not in any other age-group Medley team).

Officials and other helpers required

For all those clubs, who have either officials or people willing to help, any offer of these services would be gratefully received. Each club are asked to provide at least one, preferably two, officials from their club attend on the day.

Entry Details

The Championships are only open to members of Surrey County ASA affiliated swimming and water polo clubs, providing those members satisfy the eligibility conditions for swimming in these Championships. Master's swimmers must be 25 years and over on 31 December 2026, and Seniors must be at least 18 years of age on the day of the competition.

Following 2025's implementation of the online entry portal, this system will be used again for entries this year (2026) for both individual and relay entries. Instructions on the use of the portal can be found on the Masters meet page on Surrey website.

The entry portal can be found via: www.meetentries.co.uk

Swimmers will need to register on the system. This requires you to register your club ("Organisation" on the registration screen), your name and create a password. If you registered last year, you'll be able to log in using the account details you set up last year.

Once you have registered, or logged in, and the Meet is "Open for entries", you will be able to create, submit and pay for your entries. Once you have submitted your entry and made the payment required by card, you will get an email acknowledging your entry.

The cost of entries are as follows:

- Individual events: 50/100m £6.00, 200m £8.00.
- Relay events: £10.00.

This year we are limiting the number of individual entries to 8 per swimmer.

You are responsible for ensuring that you are fit and well to compete in this event.

The Closing Date for Individual Entries is 15th June 2026. The closing Date for Relay Entries is 22nd June 2026. No late entries will be accepted.

All events will be heat declared winners. All 200m and 100m events will be swum as MIXED events, the 50m events will remain split by gender. Over the top starts will be used wherever possible. The event is planned to finish by 19:30 at the latest. Heats will be seeded prior to the competition and we will swim with empty lanes for no-shows.


Entries, once processed, can be checked on the portal and will be published as an accepted entry list on the meet page on the Surrey County ASA website (www.surreyswimming.org). Please address any enquiries to: jboucher.esys@gmail.com.

Timing of Events

Start times and warm-up times of sessions 2 and 3 are approximate only at this stage and may be subject to change based on the number of entries received. This will be advised once the entries have closed, and event information is circulated closer to the event.

Data Protection

We will process personal data submitted by the swimmer or their club in accordance with the current Privacy Notice published by Surrey County ASA. With respect to this meet we will process personal data for the legitimate purpose of running the gala. The items of personal data processed are name, Swim England number, date of birth, and gender. During the gala we will process name, gender, and competition age in reports for the legitimate purpose of running the gala efficiently. At the end of the gala we will process name, gender, Swim

England number and date of birth in the electronic submission made to British Masters Rankings. We will also make this information available to the club of the swimmer as the data controller.

After the gala the personal data processed will be stored securely in both paper and electronic format for 12 months and then erased. This period of storage permits the accurate response to enquiries about the gala and provides statistical information for the purpose of designing the following year's gala. No personal data will remain on any electronic timing systems used to run the gala. You have the right to have your personal data erased from our systems if you have withdrawn from the gala. You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. In both cases, please make your request to the promoter.
